The proud parents, voters, and citizens of Worcester County wish to express our concerns regarding the current budget proposal and the potentially devastating impact it could have on our school system, and most critically to our children.

We are aware of a budget shortfall that is facing the Worcester County commissioners and the difficult position they are in for balancing a budget that is best for our community. We are also aware that our commissioners have expressed an intention to cut the school budget to an unnecessary degree. Our schools would be able to maintain their superior level of commitment to our children under the guidelines of Maintenance of Effort. However, by majority vote our commissioners have applied for a waiver from you to circumvent the law that requires this funding. We implore you to stand up for the protection of our children and unequivocally DENY the waiver permitting our commissioners to fund below the Maintenance of Effort level.
