Certification Defined


 A form of safeguarding the public in areas deemed important to citizens' well-being

 Official validation of entry-level knowledge, skills, and attitudes required for the profession

Importance

 Provides assurance that the professional public educational staff possess the minimum essential knowledge and skills needed to achieve the outcomes for public education declared by the MD State Board of Education

Options for Initial Certification

- Five routes to initial Maryland certification
 - Maryland Approved Programs
 - Out of State Approved Programs
 - Approved Professional Experience
 - Transcript Analysis
 - MD Resident Teacher Program

MD Approved Programs

 State Program Approval required by COMAR 13A.07.06

 State Program Approval and National Accreditation required by Maryland Statute 11-208 for institutions over 2000 full-time equivalent students (16 nationally accredited)

MD Approved Programs

 23 institutions deliver initial certification programs framed by Maryland State Board of Education adopted Redesign of Teacher Education in Maryland (1995)


MD Approved Alternative Preparation Programs

 Designed for career changers and recent college graduates

MD Approved Alternative Preparation Programs



 17 programs in 12 local school systems, with two programs pending approval

 1274 teachers currently in the first or second year of residency

- College/University course-based
- •Initial preparation of undergraduate/graduate students
- •100-day Professional Development School internship for all fulltime candidates

- Local School Systembased with partnership provider training
- Graduate-level only
- Specific entry criteria

- •4-8 week internship and 1-2 year residency required


MD Required Approved Reading Courses

Attracting Applicants

 Providing experienced professional option to qualified applicants educated in countries other than the US

 Providing experienced professional option to qualified administrators

Attracting Applicants

 Providing professionals to reinstate expired MD certificates by presenting a valid out-ofstate certificate and three years of satisfactory experience within the past seven years

Expanding options for basic skills tests

 Expanding options for the design and delivery of alternative preparation programs

Teachers

 Specifies content and professional education coursework requirements (transcript analysis) for classroom teacher areas

 Areas include early childhood, elementary, secondary, specialty areas, ESOL, and Special Education

Specialists

- Specifies advanced degree and experience requirements for specialized instructional/support roles
- Includes Guidance Counselor, Library Media Specialist, Pupil Personnel Worker, Reading Specialist, Psychometrist, School Psychologist, School Social Worker, and Gifted and Talented Specialist

Administrators/Supervisors

- Specifies advanced degree and experience requirements for administrators and supervisors
- Includes Superintendents, Supervisors of Instruction, Assistant Principals, and Principals, Supervisors of Specific Areas, Resident Principal, and Resident Assistant Principal

Specifies causes

 Requires reporting disciplinary actions to the **National Clearinghouse**

13A.12.06 Professional Standards and Teacher Education Board

25 member Board from representative constituencies

 Promulgates regulations, in conjunction with the State Board, for the certification of and requirements for the preparation of teachers and other education personnel
